## DOCUMENTATION OF ANNUAL SECURITY TRAINING

It shall be unlawful for any person to inspect or disclose in any manner not provided by law Federal tax return or return information. Unauthorized inspection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or imprisonment of not more than one year, or

both, together with the cost of prosecution. Unauthorized disclosure is a felony punishable by a fine not to exceed \$5,000, or imprisonment of not more than 5 years, or both, together with the cost of prosecution.
