**Recurring**– Happening or showing up repeatedly; occurs at <u>regular</u> or at least generally <u>predictable</u> intervals. **Non-recurring** – Occurring irregularly; having no pattern or order in time; isolated. Implies scattered, irregular, unpredictable, or isolated instances.
