EFFECTIVE: October 1, 2018

I. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this change notice is to update the benefit level amounts for the October 2018 COLA Mass Change. Changes were made to increase the maximum gross, net income limits, SUA, BUA and TUA amounts, standard deduction, the excess shelter deduction and the rounding process for income and allotment amounts (BOI). The maximum allotment amounts increased for each household, except one member households.

II. SPECIFIC CHANGES
