## **Current Change Notice: 13-18**

- The Post Eligibility Verification policy has been revised in online Family and Children's Medicaid Manual, section MA-3205, Post Eligibility Verification.
- Section 15043, Post Eligibility Verification has been removed from the IEM.

## I. POST ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION

- A. Certain information can only be requested and/or verified post (after) eligibility determination, such as:
  - 1. Information on non-custodial parents
  - 2. Application for other benefits such as:
    - a. Unemployment Benefits (UIB)
    - b. Veterans Administration (VA)
    - c. Third Party Responsibility (TPR)
    - d. Retirement, Survivors
    - e. Disability Insurance (RSDI)
- B. Once the application has been approved, send the (DMA-5097, Request for Information), allowing the beneficiary 12 calendar days to provide information.
- C. If requested information is not received, send a timely notice proposing termination for failure to provide necessary information.
- D. If the applicant has not applied for benefits, do not count any phantom benefits.
