I. BACKGROUND

The Minimum Monthly Maintenance Needs Allowance (MMMNA) and excess shelter allowance are adjusted annually in accordance with the changes in Supplemental Security Income (SSI) federal benefit rate and the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Section 1924 of the Social Security Act directs that these adjustments are effective July 1st of each year.

II. EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHANGE AND IMPLEMENTATION

- A. The Basic Spousal Allowance is \$2,289 effective July 1, 2022.
- B. The Excess Shelter Costs is \$687 effective July 1, 2022.
 - 1. For applications, use the new amounts when determining eligibility for all months beginning July 1, 2022.
 - 2. For existing cases, apply the new amounts at the first change in situation or review effective on or after July 1, 2022.
