## SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATIVE LETTER #02-23

TO: Directors of County Departments of Social Services

SUBJECT: Decoupling Private Payment Rates from Market Rates

## 1. General Information

During the recent legislative session, the General Assembly directed the Division to decouple private tuition payment rates from the subsidized child care market rates for licensed child care centers and homes, as specified by the General Assembly in Session Law 2023-14. Senate Bill 20.

## 2. Policy

New policy states that the comparison of market rate to private rate is no longer required and the approved payment rate should be the market rate regardless of the provider's private rate.

Licensed child care centers and homes with three or more stars shall receive the market rate for that rated license level for that age group. Religious sponsored child care facilities operating pursuant to G.S. 110-106 shall be paid the one-star county market rate.

## 3. Procedures

Child care providers will not need to take additional steps in order to implement

Child Care Provider Approval Notices will be updated to reflect new approved subsidy rates. Child Care Provider Approval Notices in the NC FAST Provider Portal will generate automatically, reflecting the revised approved subsidy rate effective August 1, 2023.
