I. BACKGROUND AND CONTENT OF CHANGE

The Division of Health Benefits (DHB) has revised Medicaid policy section, <u>MA-2283</u>, <u>Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)</u>. The revisions are provided below in Section II of this notice.

II. POLICY UPDATE

A. Section I - Introduction:

Update to Section A. TBI Waiver Categories

- 1. The age requirement is now age 18 and older.
- 2. Clarified that if under age 65, they must be determined to be disabled by Disability Determination Services (DDS) or Social Security Administration (SSA).

B. Section III - Budgeting

Update to Section A. Follow the basic Income rules

Updated to state that income is compared to 300% of the current Federal Poverty Level.

C. Section VI - Changes in Situation

Update to Section A. TBI Waiver Services Terminated

Clarified that a timely notice (DSS 8110) is needed if ineligible for both TBI Waiver Services and Medicaid.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE AND IMPLEMENTATION

This policies are effective October 31, 2021.
