EFFECTIVE February 1, 2003, make the following changes to the Work First Manual.

## I. BACKGROUND

In accordance with Section 404 of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, Public Law 104-193 as amended September 28, 2000, aliens known to be living in the U.S. unlawfully must be reported to the Immigration and Naturalization Service.

## **II. SPECIFIC CHANGES**

Section 111, XI. Must Illegal Aliens Be Reported To The Immigration and Naturalization Service?

This section adds new policy, criteria and instructions for reporting aliens who

are residing in the U.S. unlawfully.

## **III. IMPLEMENTATION INSTRUCTIONS**

These changes are effective February 1, 2003.
